Camping Rules and Regulations

- 1. Campsites will be reserved on a first come, first served basis. Sites will be assigned by Cheboygan County Fair and the Campground Superintendent.
- 2. Electric and non-potable water is provided at no cost.
- 3. Camping fee will be \$120 for the week of Fair. (Does not include Gate Entry Fee.).
- 4. A camping deposit of \$50 must be paid at the time of the campsite reservation. Remaining balance must be paid before moving the camper on to Fair Ground Property.
- 5. All trailers must be self-contained (gopher holes will not be allowed). Only one camper per site.
- 6. No air conditioning.
- 7. Run refrigerator on gas hook up if at all possible.
- 8. Please be courteous with electric usage. Don't leave electronics plugged in for an extended amount of time.
- 9. Please be courteous to others; dogs need to be quiet and on a 6 foot leash at all times.
- 10. Picnic tables are available on a first come, first served basis.
- 11. Cheboygan County Fair assumes no responsibility for any damage or loss of trailer or contents while on the fairgrounds.
- 12. Quiet hours are from 12am (Midnight) 6am. This means no campsite will have disturbance or excessive noise during quiet hours.
- 13. Any camper observed consuming alcohol or in possession of illegal drugs will be asked to remove their camper from the Fairgrounds immediately. Proper authorities will be notified.
- 14. Campers may pull in on the Thursday before the Fair begins.
- 15. No horse trailer parking between drive and the horse barn and/or row of trailers and the horse barn or at the ends of the horse barn. These areas are for loading and unloading only. Any horse trailer not parked in a designated area, and/or drawing electric and/or water from the barn will be charged a camping fee.
- 16. No horse trailers allowed in campground unless it has a living quarters and you are using it as a camper.
- 17. Do to liability concerns, only properly licensed and insured motor vehicles are allowed in the campground area. Personal 4 wheelers, golf carts, motorized utility vehicles, etc. are forbidden without the express written consent of the Fair Manager.
- 18. Please put all of your garbage in the dumpsters provided.
- 19. No vendors are to be set up in the camping area or in the horse area without purchasing vendor space approved by the Fair Office.
